

**Erratum to Table 6.3:
Core Indicator 2a Proposed Changes Housing Trajectory 2004 - 2026**

The Annual Monitoring Report 2007 (AMR2007) for the Yorkshire and Humber Regional Spatial Strategy (RSS) was published in February 2008. AMR2007 provided analysis against indicators found in both the current RSS as well as the then yet unpublished new Regional Spatial Strategy - The Yorkshire and Humber Plan (The Plan).

Within Chapter 6 - Housing, Table 6.3 provides a long-range trajectory of annual housing delivery by local authority. This trajectory used the target rates set out in the Proposed Changes to The Plan and past housing completion rates (2004-2008) to determine the remaining housing to be delivered till 2026. This total was then used to create a new annual housing target.

However the formulas that were used to create the figures for the 'Additional Dwellings to 2026' and 'Residual Annual Average to meet 2026 Targets' columns were incorrect. As such this erratum has been published to correct Table 6.3. An amended Table 6.3 can be found on the following page.
