

## The Data Sets

The structure of AMR2007 provides the framework for the use of the data sets found on this CD. AMR2007 is structured into 11 chapters, 3 Annexes and an Executive Summary. The data found on this CD was used to analyse specific Indicators found in Chapters 3 - 10, as well as to inform Chapters 11 (Conclusions), the Executive Summary and Annex 2 (Headline Indicators).

Data sets are presented according to the chapter that they are analysed in. A full list of indicators and whether they have been analysed in AMR2007 can be found in Annex 1 of AMR2007.

Therefore the following chapter list indicates the key themes covered by each data set spreadsheet:

Information for this analysis was derived from indicators analysed in the preceding chapters. As such no separate Data file is associated with Annex 3 though the table can be found within the Annexes spreadsheet.

## Data Supplied:

Chapters 3 to 10 of AMR2007 have an associated Excel spreadsheet file (the Data Sets). These data sets are often referred to throughout AMR2007, where reference is made regarding additional data found on the 'accompanying data CD'.

Each chapter file has a table of contents page. This page is known as the timeline, and can be navigated to by clicking on its tab at the bottom of the page (circled in illustration below). The timeline highlights when each indicator was monitored (for 2004, 2005, 2006 and 2007) and provides a link to those indicators monitored in 2006 and 2007. If the Indicator was not

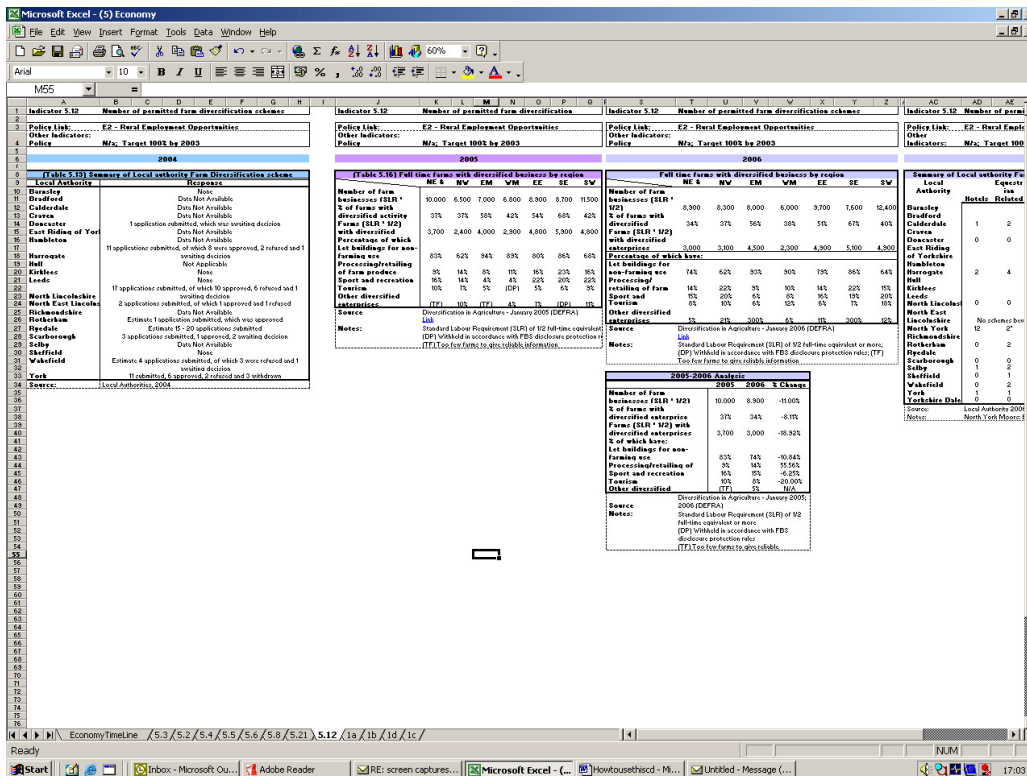
monitored in 2006 or 2007 but it was in previous years, the data has not been made available on this CD.

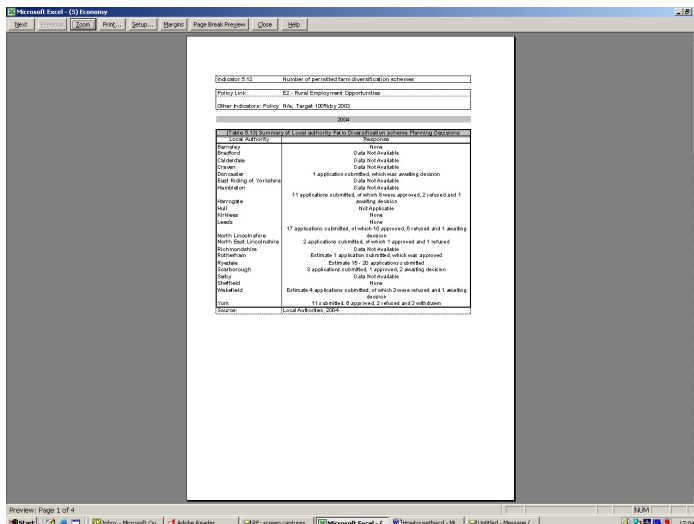
**EconomyTimeLine**

The timeline also includes general instructions on how to use the file, which are listed on the bottom part of the table.

To navigate to an Indicator, click on the link provided (red arrow on illustration above) or use the tabs on the bottom of the sheets.



The Worksheet will open up and there will be a series of tables. Tables are colour coded by year (2004 = lilac, 2005 = lilac, 2006 = pink and 2007 = orange). The tables are arranged on the worksheet so that you can print a table per page (as illustrated below).



At the top of each page the indicator Id Number and the name of the indicator is listed. Just below this, the Policy that the indicator addresses as well as any other relevant indicators, policies or targets is made available. This is illustrated below.

At the end of each table, the source data is supplied (Green Circle). Where possible, hyper-links have been used. Clicking on the link will direct the user to the appropriate internet sites. These links were correct as of February 2008.

Following the sources, explanatory notes on the data sets can also be found.
